

# Uniform Policy

From term 2, all grade dance classes are required to wear uniforms. This is to prepare the students for the examinations and give them an opportunity to get used to dancing in certain clothes and shoes.

Below is the uniform requirement for each syllabus. Lakes Performing Arts offers dance shoes and ballet outfits for sale.

## BALLET

### Females

#### Pre-primary, primary and pre-grade

- Pink cap sleeve leotard
- Pull-over pink skirt
- Ballet tights
- Pink ballet slippers

#### Grade 1 and above

- Black v-neck leotard
- No skirt
- Ballet tights
- Pink ballet slippers

### Males

- Black leotard
- Ballet tights
- Black ballet slippers

## JAZZ

### Females

- Singlet or t-shirt for class. LPAC will provide leotards for the exam day.
- Plain black  $\frac{3}{4}$  leggings
- Black jazz shoes
- Plain black ankle cut socks

### Males

- Same as females, except plain black pants

## HIP HOP

### Females

- Singlet or t-shirt for class. LPAC will provide t-shirts for the exam day.
- Plain black  $\frac{3}{4}$  leggings
- Plain white canvas shoes
- Plain white ankle socks

### Males

- Same as females, except plain black pants

## CONTEMPORARY

### Females

- Singlet or t-shirt for class. LPAC will provide a singlet for the exam day.
- Plain black  $\frac{3}{4}$  leggings
- Barefoot for dancers in Grade 6 and below
- Grade 7 and above, footUndeez are acceptable

### Males

- Same as females, except plain black pants

## OPEN CLASSES

LPAC does not have a specific uniform requirement for their open classes but ask that students do not wear school uniforms.

**Students may attend class in bare feet or soft flexible shoes; dancing in socks is not permitted.**
